PURPOSE AND CRITERIA



AWARD PURPOSE

The HealthPartners Institute for Medical Education (IME) and HealthPartners Medical Group (HPMG) **Excellence in Education Award** was created to recognize distinguished achievements by HealthPartners Medical Group physicians and dentists who have made significant contributions to teaching, innovation and leadership in education of healthcare professionals. The award was created in honor of Dr. Robert Mulhausen, first Executive Director of IME.

AWARD SELECTION CRITERIA

To nominate a physician or dentist, the nominee must have exemplified one or more of the following categories:



Contribution to student learning.

The nominee demonstrates commitment and evidence of excellence in teaching. Support may include documentation of student achievement.



Contribution to education innovation.

The nominee's approach to education demonstrates unique and novel attributes that advance the quality, efficiency and excitement of the learning experience and improves student achievement.



Contribution to educational leadership.

The nominee's actions have dramatically advanced educational activities that promote educational achievement and excellence.

Nominations can be submitted by a HealthPartners employee, a student in an IME or IME affiliated program, or alumni of an IME or IME affiliated program. The nomination is three-part:

- 1) **Nomination Form** "[Click here to go to form](#)"
- 2) **Nomination Letter**

The nomination letter defines the nominee's qualifications for the award. The nomination letter should include (as appropriate):

- teaching responsibilities
- evidence of distinguished teaching
- innovation
- publications
- special awards
- evidence of leadership
- examples of subsequent student achievement

3) Letters of Support, two or more, from peers, supervisors, alumni, or students

The physician or dentist who is selected for the **Excellence in Education Award** will receive a certificate, a monetary award, and public recognition for their significant contributions to teaching medical students, dental students, resident physicians or health professionals in practice.



Nominations will be accepted **through August 29, 2008.**
